PAGHILOM FOUNDER WINS ATENEO'S 'BUKAS PALAD' AWARD

Ateneo de Manila University recognized the groundbreaking work of Program Paghilom founder and president Fr. Flavie L. Villanueva, SVD by conferring on him the 'Bukas Palad' 2024 award on November 6, 2024. "I stand before you, not as someone better than you, more capable, more courageous or more holy than you, Thank you, Ateneo, for recognizing our work in the Foundation," said Fr. Flavie in his acceptance speech. The SVD priest was chosen "for championing the healing and rehabilitation of the families of victims of the extrajudicial killings brought on by the War on Drugs, as well as the poor, the oppressed, and the marginalized."

Accompanying Fr. Flavie to accept the award were Netherlands Ambassador to the Philippines Marielle Geraedts; priest friends; dear cousins; and several members of Program Paghilom. Chosen by the university's board of trustees, 6 other luminaries received Traditional University Awards in other fields.

EU REP MEETS EJK FAMLIES, VISITS 'DAMBANA'

On Oct. 28, 2024, European Union External Action Service (EEAS) Deputy Managing Director for Asia and the Pacific Ms. Paola Pampaloni, together with her cohort, dialogued with two widows and an orphan of Program Paghilom at the AJKFI main office. She was visibly moved upon hearing the accounts of how their loved ones were killed. After the quick meeting, she also proceeded to visit the first memorial site and



columbarium for drug war victims, the "Dambana ng Paghilom" at the La Loma Catholic Cemetery, Caloocan City.
Ms. Pamploni is the latest EU official to meet some of Paghilom's members in a desire to understand the issue of extrajudicial killings in the Philippines.

PAGHILOM PRESENTED AT by Nirva Delacruz HOUSE QUADCOMM, SENATE HEARING

In a rare chance, Fr. Flavie L.
Villanueva, SVD presented the
mission and vision of Program
Paghilom at the Senate blue
ribbon committee starting on Oct.
28, 2024 and later on, at the House
of Representatives Quad
Committee. Submitting
compelling evidence that the EJKs
indeed happened as a direct result
of former president Rodrigo
Duterte's drug war, Fr. Flavie
helped create a platform where
grassroots testimonies about the
killings could be heard.

Notably, Fr. Flavie also shared the "magic numbers" of Oplan Tokhang, which showed how 120 of Paghilom's loved ones had drug history, while 80 had none. There were also zero cases of "nanlaban" (fighting back/resisting arrest).
